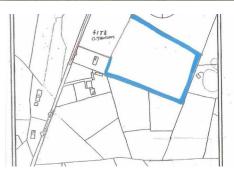

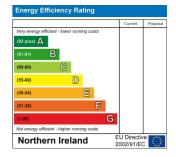

GRANTS PLANNING PERMISSION

for the above-mentioned development in accordance with your application subject to







The access gradient(s) to the dwelling(s) hereby permitted shall not exceed 4% (1 in 25) over the first 10 m outside the road boundary. Where the vehicular access crosses footway, the access gradient shall be between 4% (1 in 25) maximum and 2.5% (1 in 40) minimum and shall be formed so that there is no abrupt change of slope along the footway.

Reason: To ensure there is a satisfactory means of access in the interests of road safety and the convenience of road users.

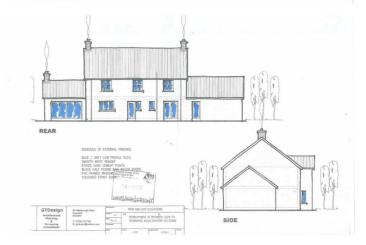
All hard and soft landscape works shall be carried out in accordance with Drawing ref 2033/04B prior to the occupation of any part of the development. If within a period of 5 years from the date of the planting of any tree, shrub or hedge, that tree, shrub or hedge is removed, uprooted or destroyed or dies, or becomes, in the opinion of the Council, seriously damaged or defective, another tree, shrub or hedge of the same species and size as that originally planted shall be planted at the same place, unless the Council gives its written consent to any variation.

Reason: To ensure the provision, establishment and maintenance of a high standard of

Trees and hedgerows shall be retained on boundaries as shown on drawing 2033/04B. Trees or shrubs dying, removed or becoming seriously damaged within five years shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of a similar size and species unless the Council gives written consent to any variation. 6.
